

Community Facilities Committee
Report to Council February 2021

A report was made on the progress of the cricket pavilion refurbishment. It is due to be completed in the projected timeframe.

The topographical study of Dog Close took place on 21st January. This is for Walton estate.

The invitation to tender for the demolition of the old youth hut and the upgrade of the car park has gone out. There have been expressions of interest.

The Newbold Road planning application is being pursued by the architect.

The new play equipment for the Mountford play area has been ordered. There is sufficient money left to purchase a bench for the Dovehouse play area to replace the fire damaged one. We are waiting for the report on what maintenance is required to ensure the structural integrity of the trim trail on the Mountford play area.

The work of the handyman was noted.

The Christmas lights were discussed. The company is being asked to inspect the lampposts and then we will be able to contact WCC about what is required. We will look at the possibility of adding extra lampposts to accommodate the increasing number of lights.

The question of the drains at Walton was raised and this has been forwarded to WCC to do the necessary work. The job has now been given a number by WCC and they will be cleared in due course.

The Street Fayre committee is looking at a village celebration in September, restrictions allowing. This would take place on the Mountford area. The identified date is September 4th. Various organisations in the village have to be contacted to ask them to take part.
